

216-4 MARKING OF CLOTHING ETC.

Anyone not having their clothing and kit marked with  
Regimental number will have this done at Q.M. Stores at once.

216-5 PROTECTION AGAINST GAS:

Decontamination equipment is placed in ablation hut  
which will be the Decontamination Centre. No one will interfere  
in any way with any of this equipment unless contaminated by gas.  
Capes Anti-Gas and curtains Helmet will be drawn by all ranks.  
Masks will be carried rolled with respirators and will be  
carefully unrolled to prevent sticking every Saturday. In future  
S&A Alarms will be given periodically without warning. On a

gas alarm being sounded all ranks without exception will wear respirators until Gas Clear is given.  
Alarm - Trench Rattle  
All Clear - Three rings on the alarm bells.

216-6 HARVEST LEAVE:

Provisions governing Harvest Leave are as follows:

It will be noted that as this is an operational Unit, same is not applicable to personnel at this Station.

1. Harvest leave may be granted on the authority of the District Officer Commanding and will be limited to the following personnel:
  - (a) Home War Establishment of Depots.
  - (b) Veterans' Guard of Canada LESS personnel employed in operational duties.
  - (c) Surplus personnel at Depot LESS those awaiting despatch to Training Centre or Units, or ~~xxxx~~ awaiting disposal after completing Advanced or Trade training.
2. The conditions under which leave may be granted are:
  - (a) Leave will not exceed four weeks duration and may be cancelled at any time.
  - (b) Leave granted will be without pay and allowances and without cost to the public.
  - (c) Soldiers will not be entitled to medical or dental attention hospitalization or compensation due to illness, injury, or death while on harvest leave.
  - (d) Only soldiers who have experience in farm work are eligible for harvest leave.
  - (e) Harvest leave will be limited strictly for the purposes it has implies.
3. Leave granted under the above conditions will be for the period as stated and personnel will be required to report back to their Units not later than 31st October, 1942.
4. It is not considered that the provisions of C.A.R.O. 1938 para 7 (a) are intended to apply to the grant of harvest leave to personnel in operational Units.
5. Application for leave will be made by the soldier concerned to his Commanding Officer who, if he approves, will forward same to the District Officer Commanding for decision.
6. The conditions governing leave will be issued in writing to the soldier before proceeding on leave and the address where he is to be employed is to be entered on his furlough form.
7. Officers Commanding will be responsible that the granting of such leaves will not interfere with the efficient operation of their Unit.
8. Officers Commanding are responsible that Personnel granted leave for periods in excess of 21 days will be boarded on M.F.B. 227 and X/Rayed prior to proceeding on leave and immediately upon return therefrom.

218-4 DRESS:

The attention of all ranks is drawn to C.A.R.O. 1342 which prohibits the wearing of forage caps with battle dress. No further infractions of this order will be tolerated. Caps Field Service are the correct head dress except on the occasions when the steel helmet or other special protective head dress is worn while on duty. This order does not affect the wearing of coloured Field Service Caps when not on duty.

218-5 WEARING OF SERVICE UNIFORM BY OFFICERS:

1. Uniform will be worn at all times when on duty or when at place of duty (except) when taking part in recreation requiring recreational clothing.)
2. At other times, plain clothes may be worn for general recreation.

218-6 FIRE PROTECTION

1. The dry season and prevailing winds now present considerable fire hazard to Camps adjacent to timber, brush, or dry grass.
2. Suitable fire-breaks will be established around all camp, and where the Area is large in addition to fire-breaks on the outskirts, others will be cut through the Camp-itself where brush or grass plots exist and create a fire hazard.

218-7 INTOXICATING LIQUOR ON TRAINS AND BOATS

1. Troops travelling by train or boat, either on leave or on duty are forbidden to carry intoxicating liquor aboard such conveyances.
2. Consumption of liquor in public places such as trains or boats is an offence against the Civil Law and offenders are liable to arrest and prosecution.
3. In future troops are forbidden to possess, transport, or consume intoxicating liquor on trains or boats.
