





1. All qualified cooks, other than C.W.A.C. and R.C.A.M.C. cooks, of units, formations, training centres, and schools, are to be transferred immediately to the Royal Canadian Army Service Corps, with effect 1 Oct 43 in accordance with the following instructions.
 - (a) All qualified cooks except C.W.A.C. and R.C.A.M.C. cooks will be transferred and carried supernumerary to the establishment of No. 1 Depot, Pacific Command, R.C.A.S.C.
 - (b) All qualified cooks except C.W.A.C. and R.C.A.M.C. cooks will then be immediately attached for all purposes to the unit, etc., from which transferred to RCASC.
 - (c) Personnel or documents will not be moved and all entries will be made in documents by present unit upon exchange of Part II Orders with No. 1 Depot Pacific Command, R.C.A.S.C.

2. Part II Orders of units concerned will record transfers and attachments by the following dates:

- (a) Training Schools, H.W.E. not later than 17 Oct 43.
- (b) Training Centres, H.W.E. not later than 17 Oct 43.
- (c) All other units and formations, H.W.E. not later than 22 Oct 43.

3. Personnel now in training as cooks, except C.W.A.C. personnel and R.C.A.M.C. personnel considered suitable for training as cooks (hospital), on qualifying as cooks will be transferred to the RCASC and their disposal effected as follows:

- (a) Unit personnel, excepting G.S. personnel eligible by age and pulse profile for service overseas will be returned to the units, from which they were despatched for training as cooks, to cover existing vacancies on the authorized establishments of those units. All other successful candidates will be despatched to A.20, Canadian Army Service
