 1. Personnel wishing to use the row-boats will first get a requisition form from the Battery Office. They will then fill out same, and present it to the Orderly Sergeant, later to be signed by the Orderly Officer. This requisition will then be taken to the Q.M. Stores where oars and carlocks will be issued. Persons will then report to Guard House and names and numbers of persons proceeding in boat will be left with Guard Commander.  
 2. The Guard Commander will keep a daily roster of persons using boats and this will be available for inspection by an Officer at anytime.



- 260-5 AMMUNITION 40 MM  
 There are two complete live rounds of 40 mm Bofors ammunition missing. These rounds are very dangerous as the fuze on them does not have to be detonated to explode the rounds. The round can be exploded by the tracer compound in the base of the shell. This makes this ammunition very dangerous to handle. When the round explodes the casing breaks up into many pieces and is thrown about in all directions.
2. The loss of these rounds must be reported to N.D.H.Q. They can be traced to this battery by the registered markings on them.
  3. To avoid a great deal of unpleasantness and disciplining action and danger, it is necessary that these rounds be returned.
