

335-4 LEAVE OF ABSENCE - ARMY PERSONNEL FOR PURPOSE OF RETURNING
TO EMPLOYMENT IN COAL MINES IN WESTERN CANADA.

Consideration will be given to the granting of leave to members of the Active Army, Members (H.D.) of the C.A. and "R" Recruits for the purpose of returning to civilian employment as coal miners. The following conditions will govern the granting of leave in this regard:

- (a) Leave will only be granted to bona fide coal miners who were so employed immediately prior to their enlistment or call up.
- (b) Leave may be granted for a period not exceeding three months.
- (c) Leave will be without pay or dependent's allowance.
- (d) Personnel granted leave will be medically boarded, including X-Ray prior to proceeding on leave.
- (e) Provisions of the Pension Act will not apply, respecting injuries or death while on leave for the above mentioned purpose.
- (f) All army equipment, save and except necessary clothing for wearing will be returned to stores, before going on leave.

335-4 LEAVE OF ABSENCE (Continued)

(g) Personnel will be permitted to wear army clothing to their destination, but will NOT wear military uniform while on leave.

(h) Free transportation warrant will be issued from present station to the place of employment, and return.

(i) Personnel so given leave, must, within FOURTEEN days of being granted leave, forward to this Headquarters, Pacific Command, Vancouver, B.C. a certificate from their employer, certifying that they are being employed as coal miners, and thereafter, on the first day of each month, an additional certificate from their employer, certifying that the employer is continuing in the employer's employment, as a coal miner.

(j) Failure to furnish a certificate called for in para (i) will automatically terminate the leave.



Attention is directed to Canadian Army Routine Order #1118 as amended by Routine Orders Nos. 1503, 2318, and 2357.

It has been brought to notice that many irregularities in connection with the use of Special Leave and Furlough Warrants, are occurring. These warrants are obtainable for transportation to a "bona fide home", as defined in Routine Order #1118. Transportation warrants are not transferrable.

No alteration of a transportation warrant is to be made except by an Officer having power to issue a warrant. When an improper alteration has been made on M.F.M. 137 disciplinary action will be taken by way of a charge, Under Section 18(5) of the Army Act, or under Section 40, as appropriate. The particulars of each such charge will contain the amount of cost incurred by the Crown, as a result of such alteration.

When an improper alteration has been made on H.F.M. 137, disciplinary action will be taken by way of a charge, under Section 18(5) of the Army Act, or under Section 40, as appropriate. The particulars of each such charge will contain the amount of any cost incurred by the Crown, as a result of such alteration.







363-4 CIGARETTES

C.A.R.O. No. 2687 is repeated for the information of all troops:-

1. Attention of all personnel is drawn to the Canadian Customs Regulation under which residents of Canada returning from abroad after an absence from Canada of not less than 48 hours are permitted to bring into Canada, duty free, not more than 50 cigars, 200 cigarettes and 2 pounds of manufactured tobacco.
2. This exemption from duty is not allowed within a period of 4 months from the date of the last exemption allowed.
3. Personnel of the Canadian Forces returning to Canada from Newfoundland, the United States or elsewhere are subject to examination by customs officers at port of entry and those having in their possession larger quantities of cigars, cigarettes or tobacco than as authorized above will be required to pay duty in the ordinary course, and failing to do so, the goods will be confiscated.
4. Personnel of the Canadian Forces will observe the above regulations strictly.
